Handel is an ordained minister of the Church of God, with general offices in Anderson, IN. He serves as the Chief Domestic Officer for the Church of God Ministries in the US and Canada. He oversees the CHOG Domestic Team serving Pastors and churches in areas of leadership development, credentialing, youth, and church multiplication. He also served 28 years at Celebration Church in Columbia, MD where he provided leadership as Deputy Pastor of Strategic Planning overseeing over 76 ministry teams, four Celebration Churches and Celebrate Recovery at Celebration Church. Churches who partner with Handel and his team are recognizing

significant growth and maturity in their ministry.

Rev. Smith's recent selection as the Chief Domestic Officer with the Church of God Ministries takes him around the country as God uses him to



advance ministry in the areas of church planting, leadership development, university and college connections, congregational health and pastoral care. He currently oversees regional pastors, youth, children, families, and senior ministries.

He is also President and CEO of HVS Solutions, an organizational and information technology consulting company advising non-profits, businesses and governments worldwide.
