



Feeling a call to ministry, she began seminary at Western Evangelical Seminary and completed her Master of Divinity at Western Seminary. She joined the Oregon Air National Guard in August 2002 where she became Oregon's first female chaplain and

She was an associate pastor at Maranatha Church in Portland for 20 years and was installed as senior pastor at Gales Creek in October 2022. "Homeless Go Bags" Mission Project

A mission project is adopted each year as part of the Willamette Valley Campmeeting. This year we will put together bags that can be given out to individuals or organizations who serve the houseless community. Here are items we are collecting:



- Socks
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Lotion or Sunscreen

- Cleaning Wipes
- Sanitizer
- Chapstick
- Gum
- Small Christian Book (New Testaments, Bible Promise book, etc.)
- Individually Wrapped Snacks (such as jerky, granola bars, crackers, hard candy, trail mix, etc.)

COMMUTERS, please fill out a registration card daily!

Thank you to EVERYONE for registering—whether you are a commuter or an overnight guest. We are required to pay for EVERYONE who comes on these grounds (\$5 daily for each day-time guest age five and above and \$13 per night for our overnight guests; you only need to pay one of the options). Your registration helps us pay our proper amount. Thank you!

Children's Ministry

Children (K-5) have a program designed just for them during the morning worship service time. Activity bags are provided during the evening services. Led by Julie Jackson, children will have a great time!

Youth Summer Impact

Young people have special activities daily, including a morning youth service. Other programming is available throughout the week. Youth registration (\$75) covers lodging, food and programming.

Recreation

Both small group and large group activities are held throughout the week, including the annual Cornhole Tournament, "Nine Square in the Air," card games and more. "Floating the river" is also available on the creek that meanders around the campgrounds.

Onsite Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided in the dining hall throughout the week on a donation basis. *Pre-registration is required*.

Onsite Lodging Option

Many choose to stay onsite the whole week or for several days. Several onsite lodging options are available: RV campsites (many with full hook-up options), tent sites, cabins and dorm rooms. Two bathhouses also help serve overnight guests.
