Greetings Friends!

I wanted to take the time in my article to highlight some of the challenges and opportunities in our Association. First, I want to thank you for your continued support for the ministry and work that we do. You are the reason we exist, and we are here to serve you however we can. It has been a relatively smooth transition as I have moved to part-time for our association and pastoring the Rockwood Church of God. The District Task Force that is working on a plan as we move forward is continuing to work with the Pacific Coast Collective (PCC) in charting a way to work more collaboratively in the future. The PCC has met on a couple of

different occasions with leadership from our respective associations. Glen Hossler, Teresa Hellstrom and Fred Douglas represented our District at these meetings. The outcome was the creation of the Fusion Center, a think tank that has been tasked with developing the strategy for building the kingdom of God on the Pacific Coast, TOGETHER. Glen Hossler and I are representing the Oregon/SW Washington Association in this venture. One of the desired outcomes is to unclog the leadership pipeline and to identify, recruit and train the next generation of pastors so that our movement can thrive. We will also be working on ways to support and resource our existing churches so we can all flourish in these challenging times. Please continue to pray for this venture as we seek to work together in the years to come.

Secondly, I want to share an urgent need for Camp White Branch. As many of you are aware, Covid-19 has been challenging for our camp. Last year we were able to have a full summer camping program thanks to a number of amazing volunteers. Our camp needs to hire a full-time Maintenance Specialist and a Operations Manager for the ongoing work. Lisa Switzer has been working tirelessly to find the needed personal to be able to offer our summer youth camps this year. To be honest, it's exciting but also a bit scary. At times, it seems like we are doing all we can to keep up with the growth and maintain the small family atmosphere. So we trust the good works we are accomplishing are the works He has prepared beforehand, and we are

doing our best to walk in them, trusting the Holy Spirit to guide our steps. We are grateful for His plans.

Greetings from Camp,

Snow continues to fall at camp. We had two rental groups over the last two months and they really enjoyed the snow (see pictures on next page). Durwood Ranton and I, along with a two other volunteers, have been hosting the groups since we have not been unable to fill our job openings at the camp.



We have an **urgent need** to fill our full time On-site Maintenance Specialist and Operations Manager roles in order to continue to service our customers and perform much needed repairs and maintenance. Talking with other camps in Oregon and the Christian Camp & Conference Association, this is an issue for all camps, not just us. Please reach out to individuals you may know and share about our positions so we can get these filled by March 31st. We have reservations starting in mid-April. Details on both positions needed can be found on our website under the jobs tab @ <u>www.campwhitebranch.org</u>. I am also happy to talk with qualified applicants who might be interested. We need to trust that God will provide individuals desiring camp ministry positions. Please continue to pray for our search for candidates and wisdom for the hiring committee.

We are once again looking for volunteers to help at the camp this summer for our Church of God camps and rentals. For each, we need an assistant cook(1) and kitchen help(1), which is typically for a 3-5 days period for each camp, with group housing/meals provided. Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older for liability purposes. This is a great opportunity to support our Camp White Branch ministry. Danette Beisley, our COG Camp Coordinator, is busy working with directors, setting up counselor training, and many other activities to support a great Summer Camp Season. This year's theme for our camps is "Jesus is the Light". The Church of God camping ministry changes lives at an early age and with our youth facing so many challenges today, we need you at camp to help make a difference in lives! We are in need of volunteer counselors (training provided) who are able to mentor and bring campers to Christ, but also want to have lots of fun! We also need 1) a certified lifeguard (all summer or for a week) so we can open the pool and 2) an individual to manage health care to ensure the safety and health of campers. Our reroofing project (dining hall, caretaker house, Fir cabin) will start in the spring once the snow melts. Prior to roofing we need to have some of the dining hall stairway awnings repaired/rebuilt, a new window put in on the north side, one of the awnings/stairways taken off to apply the roofing, and other minor repairs. If you have the skills and knowledge to help with this work, we can use your help.

Also, when reroofing starts, we can use folks to clean up when the old roofs are removed. As mentioned last month, reroofing each additional cabin will cost \$10,000 each and the office and assistant house will cost around \$20,000 to complete both from start to finish. New roofs are needed to mitigate damage to the buildings at camp since some are starting to leak. Donations can be made by sending a check to the District office or donating on our website. 
