From Albert about the day:

"I believe that holy living includes a prophetic call to critique and respond to ideas, values, and practices that are anti-Christ, contrary to the ethics of the kingdom, namely the ethic of agape love. I'd like to invite participants to dialogue together about what holiness might look like in a multiracial context, or a millennial context, or in an increasingly polarized society. What, in these times, in your city, does it look like to be set apart from the world, and set apart for the kingdom?

"As for the content of my talks, I'd like to emphasize the highly contextual nature of holiness. Since holiness is defined as being set apart, we need to consider what it is we are set apart FROM, and what we are set apart FOR. This will find expression in different ways depending on the culture in which we live. Holiness is not a matter of following a static, rigid system of laws and rules. It is a dynamic relationship/conversation between God, the Church, and the wider culture."

Albert Hung is the Lead Pastor of Trinity Church of the Nazarene, a multi-site, multi-ethnic church serving the English, Spanish, Chinese, and Filipino communities east of Los Angeles, California. After spending several years working as an educator, stage director, actor, composer, and television host, Albert received a call from the Lord to pastoral ministry in 2003 while serving as a missionary in Taipei, Taiwan. He speaks frequently on the topics of preaching, cross-cultural ministry, leadership development, and the future of the church.
