  - ⇒ Cabins are only available for the full week to parties of 3 or more persons but availability is very limited. Payment must be made in full when registering. To make a reservation for a cabin, you must first contact Pastor Steve Kufeldt (Hoodview Church of God: 503-981-1660) and then register online.
  - $\Rightarrow$  Dorm rooms are available on a nightly basis.
  - $\Rightarrow$  RV and tent spaces are also available (full hook-ups are limited).
- Meals (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) are available on a donation basis (If you plan on eating any of these meals, please register to help with planning purposes. Registration is not required but is greatly encouraged!).


