



WILLAMETTE VALLEY CAMPMEETING

Come away and spend time with the Lord in a relaxing environment and be refreshed at this year's Willamette Valley Campmeeting. Speaker Ben Hardman will unpack the theme of "Encounter God's Spirit in a Fresh Way" as he leads us in a deeper look into how the Holy Spirit is moving and working in the church. This week of inspiring worship, challenging messages, great fellowship, delicious food and activities for all ages is a great way to begin and/or strengthen relationships with others from across our district.

One of the foundational principles of this week is to provide Spirit-led times of worship and fellowship in a relaxed and unhurried schedule. We want people to grow closer to God while also growing closer to others. Volunteerism and generosity are two more foundational principles. Most of the leaders volunteer their time and even pay for their own lodging (we do pay an

honorarium to our speaker as well as pay for his or her expenses).

Financially, this ministry has seen an outpouring of support since its inception four years ago. Another foundational principle is to operate by faith and keep costs at a minimum, depending on offerings and gifts. We only charge a small fee to overnight guests, as that is the only thing we are billed for by our hosts (Oregon Christian Convention), and we cap that fee with a nightly "family max" of \$40, which is \$10 a night lower than last year. The youth who attend as part of the district youth program pay a fee of \$75, which this year is \$20 less than last year and includes lodging, programming and meals. After only offering evening meals the first year, we now serve three meals a day. Thanks to the creative talents of Steve & Val Borst, we are able to offer all meals on a donation basis. God has been faithful and this ministry has flourished the first three years. We ended last year's event with a balance of \$9,331.26. Thanks to the generosity of Holladay Park Church of God and their legacy gift of \$25,000, our current account balance is \$32,834.91.

We invite everyone in our district to join us this year. Come for the whole week or for just a day. Commuters are welcome as well as overnight guests, as we have several different lodging options in addition to meals, two worship experiences a day, plus activities for all ages. This Campmeeting, a low-key, grass-roots, offering-underwritten event, has seen significant growth each year; and is now, though planned by Region 3, a District-wide event with our District youth becoming a key part of the experience. This Spirit-filled event received a special affirmation this past year with a generous financial gift from the Holladay Park COG (Portland), after they sold their building. We also had a regional missions trip to Vicente Guerrero during Spring Break that saw about 30 participants from three churches be blessed and be a blessing – with the main project being building a house for a single mom and her family. We are still discussing when/where to have our “annual” Regional Picnic.
