Dive with us into a deeper understanding, not only of how to lead like Jesus and make disciples, but also discover the building blocks to create a culture built on disciple making. Learn the process of making disciples who make disciples through teaching, training, group exercises and future planning, .

Boot Camp 1: Paradigms (Nov. 9, 2019)

The paradigms we train in are the foundation of how we build our discipleship culture. The 7 missional truths are the foundation we build on. We've tried to reduce a lot of theology into these simple ideas because we need "hooks" like these to help us keep this reality in mind as we practice discipleship and mission. We need a way to keep these foundational truths present in our minds and bodies, because if we don't, the discipleship tools won't work as designed. In fact, unless we are running this "operating system" of missional theology, the tools may actually do counterproductive work in your culture!

Boot Camp 2: Posture (Feb.29, 2020)

No discipleship process will work unless we learn to actually lead like Jesus. Discipleship is not simply knowledge and behavior, but it is learning to live the life Jesus would live if He were you. We will discuss not only how we lead, but how we lead in the way of Jesus. Most of our time will be spent discussing how Jesus embodied grace and truth and how He modeled this for us. We will also discuss power and how we yield power in the kingdom of God.

Boot Camp 3: Practices (May 16, 2020)

We should not believe that discipleship is done without practice. Learning to make disciples, who make disciples, takes practice. We will teach the kingdom wheel and practice the process of discerning where God is at work and joining Him there. Most churches have created a healthy "teaching" culture, but we want to discuss how we become a "training" culture. Are we simply gathering people or are we equipping and sending them out?

Boot Camp 4: Presence (Aug. 22, 2020)

None of our discipleship training works without the ongoing presence of God in our lives. We will take a deep dive into what it looks like for us to learn to walk in God's presence daily. We will practice listening to him, discerning where he is at work, and we will work together to create cultures where we are encountering the living God weekly.
