Take exit 194A (the Springfield exit). This becomes I-105 and connects with Hwy 126 at the east side of Springfield. Turn left (east) at second stop light on Hwy 126 (toward Bend). Continue on 126 for about 50 miles, past the McKenzie Ranger Station. Turn right onto Hwy 242. Continue for about 7 miles to the camp. Entrance to the camp is on the right.
